The 2010 Annual Meeting of the Classical Association of the Atlantic States (CAAS) will be held in the Hilton Newark Airport Hotel in Elizabeth, NJ, on Oct. 7-9. We warmly invite you or members of your staff to join us and exhibit your materials. If you choose to be one of our exhibitors, please complete the enclosed reservation form and return it to CAAS Executive Director Mary Brown at the address listed on the form. Deadline for receipt is Sept. 15. Mary Brown will provide for your display and give you further information, particularly in regard to shipping your materials.

Each exhibitor may send up to **two** representatives; both will receive exhibitor credentials and free registration for the meeting. The reservation form doubles as a registration form for your representatives and display tables (there is a small handling charge for each.) At this time we cannot guarantee more than one table per exhibitor, but after Sept. 15, when we know how many tables have been requested, we can confirm the number of tables you will be able to have. You will receive a printed program (also available at <http://caas-cw.org/2010program.html>) for each representative as soon as we have processed your reservation form.

The CAAS registration desk will be outside Elizabeth A., where the Book Display will be. Panels and paper sessions will be held in rooms nearby. We expect that many attendees will examine your materials during the conference. If you choose to make a donation towards the coffee break, we will advertise your sponsorship on a printed sign next to the refreshments. We hope you will join us for meals, where you can enjoy conversation with our participants. Exhibit hours are 8:00 A.M. to 4 P.M. on Friday and 8:00 A.M. to 1P.M. on Saturday. You may begin setting up as early as 8:00 P.M. on Thursday, when the conference is beginning and as early as 7:30 A.M. on Friday and Saturday. All exhibits must be removed by 1:00 P.M. on Saturday. Although the room will be locked when not in use, neither the Hilton Newark Airport Hotel nor CAAS assumes liability in event of theft or damage.
